Garden Valley School Division Graduation rate and calculation description – As per Garden Valley School Division, calculation rate determined as follows:

“All incoming grade 9 students have an expected graduation date based on the normal 4-year program. Students transferring in part way through high school have their expected grad date based on the current grade they transfer into. In any given year, based on the above, we have an 'Expected # of Graduates'. We then subtract the number of students who have transferred out resulting in a 'Possible Number of Grads'. Dividing Actual Grads by Possible Grads gives you the Grad Rate Percentage.”
