The scholarships that have been established will assist and reward students in their first degree or diploma of post-secondary study.

This **Ongoing Education Support Scholarship** is intended for students of the Winkler area, 30 years of age or under, **who are either:**

A minimum of three (3) new scholarships, valued at \$2,000 each, will be awarded each year.

Scholarship applicants will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- ✓ Academic performance
- ✓ Community/volunteer involvement
- ✓ Response to essay question

The scholarship (\$2,000 per year) is renewable for up to two (2) additional, consecutive years if a minimum GPA of 2.5 is maintained.
